



PREVENTING AND RESPONDING TO CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT TRAINING

Completing the Course

This state-certified course does have a lot of good information regarding the hard subject of child abuse and neglect. Just remember, they don't have the same Biblical Worldview as we do, so we may not agree 100% with every single thing they say.

This is a 2-hour course that must be completed before you come to camp.

Please pay close attention to the information given because it can become useful for helping others. Lord willing, you won't need to use this information, but we all need to be prepared for the situations God sends our way. This is not an enjoyable topic, but it is part of the world we live in, and sometimes part of the ministry you will be a part of. Use Biblical discretion and please understand that some of what you will hear may or may not be the way you believe or the way the camp believes. This course is provided and required by the state of Colorado.

To access the course:

1. Click on this link - [Colorado Shines PDIS Login](#)
2. Login or create an account (This is the same website where you take the Standard Precautions course that is also required for all our summer staff members. If you have already taken the Standard Precautions course, you can just use the same login you used for that to login.)
3. Scroll down to a section called "Training Requirements for Child Care Centers and Preschools" and hit the dropdown arrow next to the number 5.
4. Click on "Preventing and Responding to Child Abuse and Neglect."
5. On the right-hand side of the screen is a button that says register. Click it. If you don't see the button, make sure that the course tab is full screen.
6. Follow the instructions to complete the course.
7. **Upon completion, you will need to send us your certificate of completion.** To do so - scroll to the top of the page and click on "Learner Home" under the "Learning" dropdown.
8. Scroll down and click on "Go to My Trainings"
9. Filter by "completed", click on "View Completion" beside Recognition and Reporting of Child Abuse & Neglect, then click on "View my Certificate"
10. Download the certificate and email it to the TMBC office.
